Information for new students in 2019

Beimid ag oscailt arís i gcóir na scoil bliana 2019/2020 ar an gCéadaoin an 28ú Lúnasa 2019.

School will reopen for the school year 2019/2020 on Wednesday 28th August 2019. School commences daily at 9.20am and finishes at 2pm for Junior and Senior infants and 3pm for 1st class to 6th classes. We encourage children to arrive 10 minutes early so that they can enjoy some time in the yard before settling down to lessons. We provide an after school club from 2.00pm - 4pm for those who wish to avail of after school supervision at a fee. Children should not however be on the premises before 9.00am as they are not covered by insurance at that time.

First 2 weeks of school:

Junior infants will go home at 1pm from Wednesday 28th August to Friday 30th August. From Monday 2nd September they will finish at the regular time of 2pm.

A packed lunch including a drink is required daily. We are a health promoting school and encourage healthy eating. A small treat however is allowed on Friday only. For safety reasons, instant hot food e.g. pot noodles, cup a soups etc. are not allowed. Chewing gum, fizzy drinks, lollipops and crisps are forbidden at all times.

Please note that due to a pupil with a peanut and egg allergy in the school, we ask that you don't include these items in your child's lunch at any time.

Your child's first day at school is a day to remember for the rest of his/her life. You can help to make it a really happy day for your child by telling him/her about school beforehand. Talk about it as a happy place where there will be a big welcome for him/her and they will meet new friends. When you arrive at the classroom, be as casual as you can. They will meet the teacher and

the other children and will be encouraged to take part in an activity. Hopefully they will be absorbed in the new surroundings so you can leave having assured him/her you will be back to collect them later.

- All items of the school uniform will be available from our appointed supplier, Catherine Hourihane, Tots to Teens in Skibbereen, (Tel: 028 22456). We stock a small supply of the school crests if you want to purchase a red cardigan/jumper & sew them onto it. All jumpers and cardigans require a school crest.
